ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. Candidate must have passed final year examination from an O.T. School/College recognized by AIOTA.
2. Candidate must have passed each examination in first attempt.
3. Candidate must have secured minimum of 60% marks in the final year/semesters' examination and declared passed in the calendar year preceding the year in which the examination for selecting the candidate for the award is conducted by the Orissa Branch of AIOTA.
4. Application must be forwarded and recommended by the Head of School/College/Institution.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Completed application should reach the Convenor, Orissa Branch of AIOTA at least two weeks before the commencement of the N.C. of AIOTA of the corresponding year.
2. Copy of the application must be forwarded to the Organizing Secretary & Chair Person, Scientific Programme Committee of the forthcoming conference.
3. The candidate will be screened by a formal written examination which will be conducted on the 2nd /3rd day of the conference.
4. The venue for the examination will be arranged by the Organising Secretary in consultation with the Chair Person, Scientific Programme Committee.
5. Maximum two candidates from each school/college/institute, subject to eligibility criteria, will be permitted to appear the examination.

METHOD OF EXAMINATION:

1. Question paper will contain approximately 45 M. C. Q.
2. Duration of the examination will be 45 minutes.
3. The medal and certificate will be awarded by the Chief Guest during the valedictory function of the conference.
